## IMPORTANT TIPS FOR YOU

You need hard copies, so don't delay! This is just a reminder that all documents concerning salary and retirement benefits should be kept at home in a folder. The classroom is not a secure place to store information. You never know when some record might be needed, especially when you are about to retire.



## CAREFUL DRIVING

Now that April is here, we are enjoying some warmer weather after a cold and windy winter. As you are driving around town, you are seeing many road workers making repairs to the roadways. In March two workers were run down and killed while doing their jobs fixing our roads. The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) is upset by the loss of workers trying to do their jobs to make our commutes better. VDOT is asking everyone to please lower your speed while driving through a work area. Too many drivers disregard the posted speed limits. It would also help if you turn on your headlights so that a worker can see you approaching.

## SICK LEAVE DAYS

FCFT advises our members to keep twenty days of sick leave in their accounts, just in case something happens for which short-term disability (STD) would be needed. Before short-term disability begins, there is a twenty-day elimination-period. This means, days one through twenty will be your sick leave days. Day twenty-one will begin short-term disability.

If an employee does not have twenty days of sick leave, those days will become leave without pay.
